

## **Improvisational Wirework**

MATERIALS LIST -Students must have tools, wire and beads for 1st Class.

- Cloth to work on: old pillow case, etc.
- Small metal ruler marked in inches and in metric (6" or 12")
- Cloth measuring tape

## Tools:

- chain nose pliers
- round nose pliers
- wire cutters (the blue handled wire "nippers" are a good choice or red handled ones from Italy)
  \*\*\*\*NOTE: STUDENTS MAY USE 92Y TOOLS IN CLASS May want to wait to purchase

Wire assortment: Copper and/or colored copper: 20g, 22g, 26g., possibly 18g (optional)

Buy round wire. Several wire manufacturers produce colored copper:

ParaWire and Artistic Wire are both quality "craft" wires - have lots of great colors. Do not buy German style wire - too hard to work with. Sold on spools - 25 feet for 20g and 22g, 6 yards for 26g - these are small spools... probably will want to have 2 spools of each size.

If buying Sterling or Gold-filled or Bronze - order "dead soft" so that it is easier to manipulate.

**Misc. beads** – an assortment of sizes – odds and ends are fine – glass, semi-precious, etc. as long as they fit on the wire!.

- Sharpie Extra fine permanent marker
- Note pad and pen/pencil

## Weekly Schedule:

Week 1: Basic wire working skills and discussion of wire & tools. Practice wire & Misc. beads. Preview of upcoming projects. Basic Eyes - 20g wire Wrapped wire eyes - 22g wire

Week 2: Finish up Basic wire working skills, explore twisting and winding of wire. Lots of 26g - 2 colors would be great.

Week 3 & 4: Free-form cuffs and necklaces. All wire sizes (if fingers are strong enough: 18 g). Asst'd beads.

Weeks 5 (and 6): To Be Determined.
