Beaded Beads

Beads needed:

- Seed Beads: small amounts of 8/0, 6/0 and 11/0(Japanese seed beads work best)
- small Miyuki drops - may be used as an embellishment
- 4mm round fire polish beads approx. 40 per beaded bead
- Wooden beads will be provided for projects

- **Thread: Nymo D or equivalent. Fireline 6lb or 8lb
- **Needles: #10 Stiff English beading needles
- **Bee's wax for thread
- Small sharp scissor or cutter for Fireline
- Cloth to work on (old pillow case works well)
