Star setting is a vintage technique that was very popular in Victorian jewelry. With the use of special engravers students will learn to raise beads, form a star and secure the stones in place.

Gypsy setting. This technique is also referred to as burnish setting. In this setting a gem is embedded into the metal and set flush to it's surface.
