## Supply List

Unleaded enamels are supplied in class.

· 2-3 fine sable brushes (e.g. one each: # 0, #00; #000)

- · 1 Flat ½" 1" brush
- · An old toothbrush

 $\cdot$  A sharp tool for sgraffito. (e.g. a fine-pointed scriber - available at the hardware store - is best, but a needle will do.)

- · Small Scissors
- · Fine-pointed tweezers
- · 6" x 6" mica sheet (available at Metalliferous or Allcraft)

· Containers for enamels. (Suggestions: tiny plastic toy cups; round, stacking fishing tackle containers; mini-tupperware cups; any other small plastic or foil containers in which enamels can be mixed)

- $\cdot$  Pencil and paper and design ideas
- · 18 gauge copper (6" x 6")
- $\cdot$  18 gauge copper discs or squares (2"-4")

- · Jeweler's saw frame and blades.
- · Silver (FINE only)
