On this amazon list they can purchase:

1-Papermaking frame kit (w/ set of 3 moulds & deckles)

1-pack of 20 Couch blotter sheets

1-big sponge

1-pack pulp

Additional Items they will need (& can find from around the house):

-A plastic wash tub or storage container with a removable lid needs to be at least 17"Lx14"Wx6"D so that the dip mold and 2 hands can comfortably fit inside.

-plastic cups

-recycled paper (white & colored) shredded or in sheets with no plastic

-additional sponges (bigger is better)

-stencils, cookie cutter shapes, stamps, shells, sand, dried flowers, twigs & leaves, ribbons, etc I will have a blender on site for the pulp making but if they have an old blender they want to use they are definitely encouraged to bring it to make more pulp.

& lastly, if they have a dip mould & deckle they can use that & do not need to purchase the kit but will need the sponges, couch paper and the other "additional items".
