WIRED: Bead and Wire Chains

SUPPLY LIST

Cloth to work on: old pillow case, etc.

Small metal ruler marked in inches and in metric (6" or 12")

Tools: chain nose pliers, round nose pliers, wire cutters (the blue handled or red handled wire "nippers"

are a good choice)

Wire: Copper or Beadalon Artistic Wire or ParaWire (must be copper base)

Dead soft sterling, gold-filled, or bronze for final projects. 6 ft each of 26g, 24g, 22g, and 20g

Brass or Beadalon German style wire 22g and 20g **Beads**–Assortment of sizes, shapes, etc. no plastic

Sharpie Extra fine permanent marker

Note pad and pen/pencil

wooden dowels: 1/8" and up in size (sold in sets for chain making)

nail file 2 sided - one side fine and one side coarse

There will be tools and some practice wire available for use in class.

.All supplies needed will be discussed in the First Class.

- WEEK 1 Wire wrapped eyes using all sizes of wire. Beads must fit on the wires.

 Beads should be 6mm and up in size. Commercial clasp optional

 Commercial chain optional.
- WEEK 2 Wire wrapped eyes large using 20g wire. Beads: larger ones work best.
- WEEK 3 Basic eye 20g brass Beadalon German style wire or brass. Beads: 6mm or larger.
- WEEK 4 & 5 Spiral elements used to create chains. 22g, 20g or larger Begin with the classic chain of connected spirals and explore additional element to use in unique chains.
- WEEK 6 A few more fun techniques to play with as well as finishing up projects.
